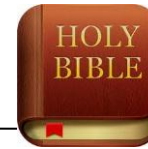

Talking it over (use this for discussion around your community group):

- Have someone in your group read (or summarize) the main passage for today.
- An obstacle is something that stands in the way of you and the place you want to be or the thing you want to achieve. Can you think of some of the bigger obstacles you've had to face? Share with others one of those obstacles, and what happened: Did you overcome it? How? If not, why not? If it's a current one, what are you doing to overcome it?
- Think about your spiritual journey. As you grow in your understanding of God and relationship with Him (as much as you might know about it right now), what are some obstacles you are facing?
- Has there been something "big" you've wanted to accomplish in your life, or that you believe God is asking you to do? If so, what are the obstacles you are facing or might face? How will you deal with those?
- What do you think God wants to accomplish in our church (think big!)? How will we accomplish it? What obstacles might we face?

Digging Deeper (if you still have time, or for further study later, go through these questions):

- What would go through your mind if you were in the army that marched around the city each day? What would you be thinking if you were Joshua? What doubts or struggles do you think went through Joshua's mind as he led the people around the city each day?
- What effect (if any) did the taunts of the people on the wall have on the Israelites? When you are faced with an obstacle in your Christian life, who or what does the "taunting" to you? How do you deal with it?
- Do you have faith to believe that God can do impossible things through your life? Through your church? What hinders your faith? What can you do to strengthen your faith?
- Re-read through your notes. Review the main points and read the Scripture references that are provided for you.**
